- The C2CI pilot project „Eternal Holiday Housing“ is briefly presented, islands of the Uthlande are interested in participating as they see possibilities on their islands.

In regard of promotion activities a exhibition of the „Biosphäre Halligen“ is presented, to show how panels and design can be done. The german C2CI partners plan to develop some panel in german and to translate and publish the C“CI flyer in german too. Katja Hansen will support this.
